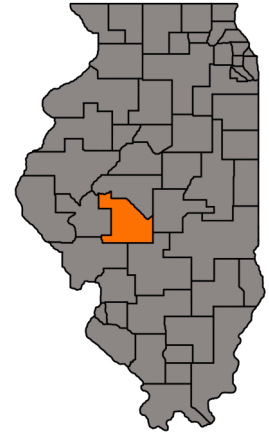


Regional Office of Car/Tech Educ - 310
